

JAMES W. GRICE FACT SHEET

- Sentenced to 2 years imprisonment in Missouri after pleading guilty to writing a check with insufficient funds.
- Convicted of fraud in Texas and sentenced to 45 years in prison. Was to be on parole until 2024.
- Convicted in Illinois with St. Louis attorney of 7 counts of securities fraud, 2 counts of theft by deception, and 1 count of deceptive practices.
- Estimated by authorities to have bilked investors out of more than \$5 million.
- Is a former resident of St. Louis, hometown of Canice Timothy Rice, attorney for St. Peter pastor Joseph Jarmoluk.
- Now resides in the Fox Valley.
- Possesses the same name that Caller I.D. listed on a return call made to CTLNYC-advertised toll-free number. CTLNYC purports to be a media company doing a documentary on Jarmoluk called 'Forsaken'.
- Matches the description of a man overseeing filming of 'Forsaken' at the Kane County Courthouse.
- Has an associated name of 'Thomas Farnsworth' which is also the name given as the "attorney" and later "producer" of CTLNYC.
- CTLNYC 'radio host' uses the name of Brett 'Rocky' Hamilton. Brett Hamilton, a public address announcer for the Philadelphia Flyers has told his employers that someone else was using his identity.
- A local newspaper published a letter signed by "J. Thomas Morlan, Executive Producer, CTLNYC Media, New York City". No public records of anyone with that name exist in the state of New York.
- A former vocal supporter of Jarmoluk wrote to blogger Fred Martinez, "The person making the documentary that contacted me I later realized was fabricating his identity".
